

Bannock County Farm Bureau 2017 Scholarships

Bannock County Farm Bureau will be awarding scholarships with a top scholarship of **2000.00**. Scholarship recipients will be selected by the BCFB Scholarship Committee. The number of scholarships may vary from year to year.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution.

1. **DEADLINE** for scholarship applications is **March 14, 2017 at 5:00 pm**.
2. Bannock County Farm Bureau will use the **COVER PAGE** and the **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION** pages only of the **Idaho State Farm Bureau Application**. **Do not print page two stating the Idaho State Farm Bureau RULES.** (Refer to the bottom of the page for web site)
3. **Please follow the Bannock County Farm Bureau Application RULES EXACTLY** as stated:
 - A. Farm Bureau Scholarships are limited to one per recipient.
 - B. An **official transcript of High School** or if already attending college, an **official college transcript**.
 - C. **Three (3) current letters of recommendation must accompany all applications.**
 - D. A recent photograph. **Please do not use staples** to attach the picture to the application.
 - E. Use the current 2017 scholarship application, extra pages may be added to complete the application if necessary. You may make copies of this application.
 - F. **DO NOT PUT APPLICATIONS IN FOLDERS.**
 - G. **LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Applicants must be a Farm Bureau member.
2. A graduating 2017 senior or an individual pursuing a college degree.
3. Cumulative GPA 2.5 or above.
4. Funds may be deferred for up to 3 years upon approval.
5. Be willing to report how the scholarship benefitted them to the Bannock County Farm Bureau Board.

3. An official transcript of High School or if already attending college, an official college transcript. Three letters of recommendation must accompany all applications.
4. A recent photograph will be used for publicity purposes only. Please don't use staples to attach the picture to application.
5. Complete & return this application to your county Farm Bureau office for verification of membership, signature of the County President and completion of the section below. Please check with your county office for the deadline.
6. Extra pages may be added if necessary. Incomplete applications will not be judged. All applications need to be on the current scholarship application. You may make copies of this application. DO NOT PUT APPLICATIONS IN FOLDERS.
7. Each county may submit **TWO applications. One for Ag-Related field of study and one for NON-Ag Related field of study.**

The County Farm Bureau is responsible for the recommendation and selection of the county applicants and researching the application as to membership and the qualifications of the applicant. The County President must interview each applicant before signing the completed application.
